Questions and Answers:

Question 1: Please clarify the answer to Question 1 of Addendum #1 issued today. How far apart do we need to install the temporary tab type markings for lane lines, center lines and stop bars? Do you have a material specification for the “tab type markings”?

Answer 1: The recommended spacing for Temporary Raised Pavement Markers are as follows:

- For broken line spacing, 4 markers at 3-1/3' spacing leaving a 40' gap.
- For single line, 10' on center on tangents and 5' on center on curves greater than 6 degrees.
- For temporary stop bars, four per lane width, evenly spaced.

We currently do not have a specification for these types of markers, but we will accept any of those approved by VDOT and typically used in this region.
