### Crime Trends:

- Decreases in Group A and Part 1 crimes. Increase of 1 occurrence in Violent Crime, slight decrease in Property Crime
- Homicide investigation of 22 yr. old male from NJ occurred as a result of a large fight continues
- Narcotic cases numbers are the same however heroin cases continue to be a concern
- Fraud /impersonation cases increased similar to region wide trend - Person(s) using identity theft to file false tax returns.
- Calls for Service 17% higher in 2015

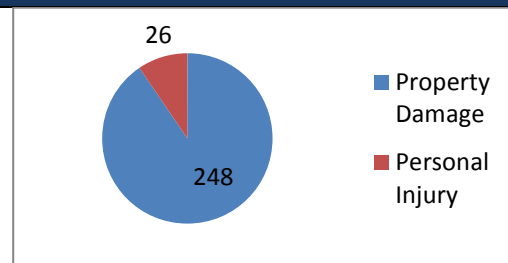
