Showers and storms wash pollutants into the storm sewer system and downstream into waterways. Please use fertilizer, pesticides and herbicides carefully! Excess chemicals can easily be washed into the storm sewer system causing damage to downstream plants, animals and waterways.

In addition to lawn and garden chemicals, residents are reminded that pouring anything into the storm sewer system is a violation of Section 14-24 of the Town Code. This includes, but is not limited to, motor oil, paint & paint thinners, gasoline, chemically treated pool water, etc. The only thing that should be going down the storm drain is rain!
