



Leesburg Police Quarterly Crime Report

January-September 2015

Est. Population: 49,600

Total Calls For Service: 2014: 38,374 2015: 40,476

Crime Trends:

- Slight decrease in Group A incidents
- Increase in Part 1 crimes specifically larceny – Shoplifting (note Part I for first 2 quarters was 36% over same period 2014; increase for 3 quarters of 2015 has dropped to 5.7% over same period 2014)
- Increase of 15 occurrences in Violent Crime
 - Increase in Rapes (7). In all cases the suspect is known to victim (acquaintance).
 - Several occurred 8-10 years ago; in several cases prosecution was declined due to a lack of evidence
 - Increase of 7 in aggravated assaults – majority of these are relationship based
- Narcotic cases show slight decrease; heroin cases continue to be a concern
- Calls for Service 5% higher in 2015 than the same period for 2014

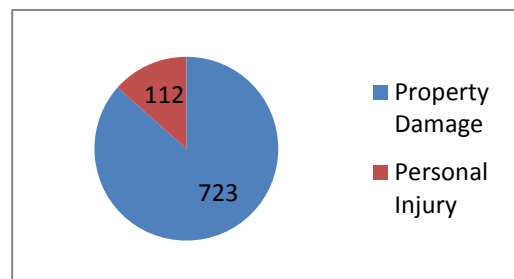
