Crime Trends:

This report also contains preliminary information regarding Part 1 and Part 2 crime statistics that have been reported to the Virginia State Police and the total number of vehicle crashes sorted by type, as well as the top intersection areas where crashes have occurred.

- Slight decrease in Group A incidents
- Slight increase in Part 1 crimes, particularly Motor Vehicle Thefts
- Violent Crime is down 10%
- Heroin cases continue to be a concern
- Calls for Service 6% higher in 2015 than the same period for 2014
- Highest intersection crash location continues to be E. Market Street and Battlefield Parkway

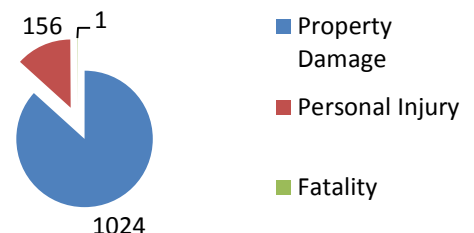
