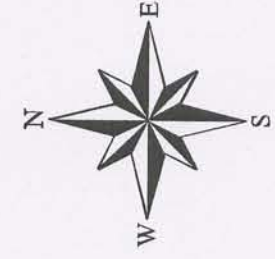


Park Name: Catoctin Skatepark
