# Helpful Information for Property Owners

## HISTORIC DISTRICT ARCHITECTURAL SURVEY UPDATE PROJECT 2024-2025

1	During the survey, architectural historians from our consultant, Stantec, will take photographs of all properties (regardless of age) from the public right-of-way using tablet computers to record details about architectural style, exterior materials, and alterations.
2	The survey team will be wearing neon vests and will have business cards and a copy of the notice letter mailed to property owners. The surveyors will not ask to come inside your building - if someone claims to be documenting your structure and cannot produce identification, call <b>571-498-1233</b> .
3	This survey does not affect your taxes - it will not raise or lower your taxes. It will not establish legal boundaries. It is only to document the age, materials, and architectural style of your building.
4	You will receive a copy of the survey report once it is completed. Staff is happy to help you interpret the results.
5	Throughout the course of the project, our consultant historians welcome input from the public regarding property histories, so please feel free to engage with them.
