

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

Fall and Winter Safety Guide



Wear Bright Colors!

Choose fluorescent or bright-colored clothing during the day. White and light colors are most visible in low light conditions.



Wear Reflective Gear!

Wear reflective clothing, accessories, or tape. Reflective materials can be seen from 500+ feet away when vehicles are using headlights.

Carry a Flashlight

Use a flashlight or phone light when walking in dark areas. Face oncoming traffic so drivers can see you!



Be aware of the time!

Remember sun sets earlier in fall & winter. Plan your route to avoid walking in complete darkness.

Make Eye Contact!

Ensure drivers see you before crossing. Never assume a driver has seen you, especially in low light.



Use the Crosswalks!

Always use designated crosswalks and obey traffic signals and signs. Look both ways multiple times before crossing, including those turning from left or right.



Don't Be Distracted!

Put away phones and remove headphones when crossing streets. Stay alert to your surroundings!



Allow Extra Time!

Allow extra time for your journey and don't get into a hurry. Rushing increases the risk of accidents and poor decision making!



REMEMBER: Drivers have reduced visibility and longer stopping distances in fall and winter conditions. Always assume you haven't been seen and take extra precautions! Wear proper footwear in icy conditions and avoid walking in severe weather.
